

					<p>City Airport (10 miles east of the School) Take the Docklands Light Railway from the airport to Tower Hill and then take the London Underground to Baker Street. www.londoncityairport.com</p> <p>Heathrow Airport (13 miles west of the School) Take the Heathrow Express train to Paddington Station and then the London Underground to Baker Street. Alternatively, take the London Underground to Baker Street. www.heathrowairport.com</p> <p>Gatwick Airport (25 miles south of the School) Take the Gatwick Express train to London Victoria Station or London Bridge Station and then the London Underground to Baker Street. www.gatwickairport.com</p> <p>Luton Airport (25 miles north of the School) Take a Thameslink train to West Hampstead and then the London Underground to Baker Street. www.london-luton.co.uk</p> <p>Stansted Airport (30 miles north east of the School) Take the Stansted Express train to Liverpool Street Station and then the London Underground to Baker Street. <p>The map shows the route from the Greater London area through Central London to the Local area and Campus. The route starts at Marylebone Station, goes north on Baker Street to the Baker Street tube station, then east on Allsop Place, and finally south on Park Road to the main school entrance. Key landmarks include the Sherlock Holmes Museum, Francis Holland School, and the University of Westminster.</p>				<p>Baker Street tube station has four exits – three on Marylebone Road and one on Baker Street.</p> <p>Exit from the Baker Street (north) exit next to Boots the chemist. Turn right onto Street and you will pass the Transport for London Lost Property Office.</p> <p>Continue up Baker Street towards Regent's Park until you see the Sherlock Holmes Museum (on the opposite side of the road).</p> <p>Continue across Allsop Place at the traffic lights and turn left onto Park Road.</p> <p>Walk along Park Road for about two minutes. You will pass the Francis Holland School on your left followed by the Rudolf Steiner House.</p> <p>Shortly after the sign for the School's Behavioural Research Lab on your right, you will see the entrance to the School signposted as below:</p> <p>The School entrance from Park Road</p>

Rooms

Naming convention for rooms is: wing, followed by floor, followed by room e.g. E201 is in E Wing on the second floor, A126 is in A Wing on the first floor.
